What we grow	When to expect it at market
Basil	Early July until 40-degree nights
Chard	Early July to frost
Garlic, fresh & uncured	Early July to early August
Cucumbers	Late July till mid-September
Tomatoes	Mid-July till September something
Summer squash (yellow and green)	Mid-July till September
Beets	Late July to frost
Carrots	Late July to end of season
Heirloom tomatoes	Late July till September something
Cured garlic	Mid-August till sold out (usually early October)
Garlic scapes	Mid-June for 2 weekends
Walla Walla onions (sweet) & red onions	Mid-July until sold out (September or October)
Eggplant	Second half of July until the frost
Yellow storage onions	August till sold out
Leeks	mid-July (narrow ones) or mid-August (thicker ones) till sold out
Shallots	August till sold out
Peppers (both sweet & hot)	Mid-July until the frost. (Red ones later: late August or early September)
Winter squashes (butternut, acorn, sugar pumpkins)	September until hard frost
Flowers (zinnias, sunflowers)	Late July till frost. Potter asters & mum in September-October
